Corbeau Seats Rally Tendring and Clacton 2023

Marshal/Officials registration procedure

The Corbeau Seats Rally Tendring and Clacton (CSRTC) is using the Rally Stage Team (RST) system for marshals and officials' registration for the 2023 event.

Many of you will be familiar with RST as it is used by many events, but if you are not, then you register your details with RST at <u>RallyStageTeam.co.uk</u> and obtain a login and once logged in to the site you can register for any event managed by RST.

On-Stage Marshals and Officials

Having selected to register for CSRTC you are required to select a preferred stage from the list. The Stages are:

Saturday

Sunday

Any Stage on Sunday (SS 3-14)

If you don't have a Sunday Stage preference you can select the Any Stage option and we will allocate you to the stage where resources are required.

Having selected the stage, it takes you to the 'Attendance Details' screen. Choose the 'As Part of a Group' option, even if you are on your own. This then gives the option to act as Group leader or join someone else's group – if you are on your own select the 'Group Leader' option. On the next screen you are then able to say how many are in your group, how many cars, and specify the car types this is useful information when the post allocations are done to ensure the marshals parking is suitable for the type of car they have. (There is a separate document to explain how to enter car details if you have already registered without doing so.)

You will then be asked to enter a requested role from a limited list of Marshal, Radio Assistant, Radio 'C' System or Timing. If your role doesn't fall into one of these categories, then use 'Marshal' and enter your actual role in the 'Notes' box along with any other information you wish to provide, we will then update your role on the allocation list.

If you want to attend the Saturday stage and a Sunday stage, then you just repeat the process for each day.

When we receive your registration, we will allocate you to the stage and the Stage Commander will allocate the specific junction.
